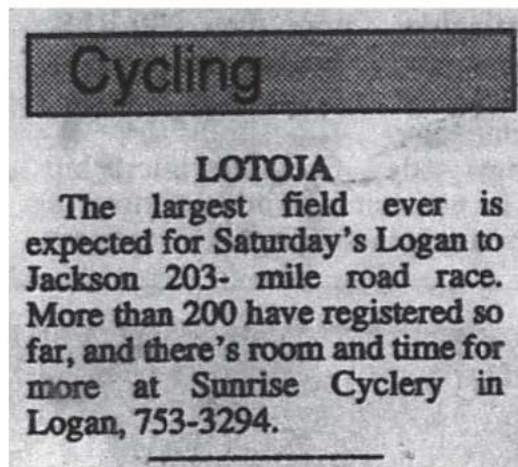

# LotoJa could be fastest yet

Cyclist Scott Morrison will discover what he is made of Saturday.

He might find out wheeling over Tincup Pass in Idaho, or the hilly climb past Freedom, Wyo.

Either way, it will be too late to turn back from his first LotoJa Classic.

The Classic, which began back in 1983 with nine riders, has turned into a monster. Race organizer Ron Stagg expected a record two hundred-plus riders to begin the 203-mile, three-state journey from Logan early Saturday morning.

The longest United States Cycling Federation sanctioned event will involve riders from Colo., Calif., and even Chicago. Great conditions and the most Category I riders ever could mean the eight-hour, ten-minute course record is in jeopardy.

Some riders like Morrison don't envision themselves setting a record, or even coming close. Just conquering the grueling course is compensation enough for him.

Morrison, fresh from an LDS mission, has logged one hundred miles in one stretch before, but never two hundred. He only hopes to reach the finish line in Teton Village, Wyo., under 11 hours.

Some won't reach the finish line until after dark. Others won't make it at all. Crashes took their toll on a number of riders last year, said Stagg.

"It's a unique race," he said of the European classic style event. "Other races aren't long enough to take on food and water." But for LotoJa, five feed zones are set up along the course for riders.

Even Wednesday, LotoJa phone calls were still coming into the backshop of Sunrise Cyclery. No, Stagg didn't know if registration materials would arrive by today's deadline. No, partisan mechanical support vehicles will not be allowed this year.

"It's beyond me," said Stagg. "Why do you do this?" he asked Morrison standing nearby.

"I don't know," admitted Morrison from Brigham City. "It's the challenge, I guess."

If Stagg gets his wish, conditions will once again be favorable.

"I put my order in for tail winds out of the south, 70 degrees," said Stagg.

The combined licensed and public riders will zoom up to Preston and then over through Grace and Soda Springs, Idaho. The first licensed rider up Tincup Pass will be forever known as King of the Hill. The winner of the "race within the race," will also be awarded a cash amount for his troubles.

In the interest of everybody's safety, Stagg said only neutral mechanical support vehicles will be used this year. Less traffic on the road means less chance of pileups involving cyclists.



I'm looking forward to seeing you on Sept. 19, 1992 for next years race. We are looking forward to a big event to celebrate our 10th year.
